Raising Awareness! Focus on: Holiday Gift Giving for Children with Additional Needs



When purchasing a gift for a child, many people look at the recommended ages on the front. When purchasing a gift for an additional needs child, please consider cognitive age, mental and physical ability.

If the child has delays in language or social skills for example, look for toys that are at their ability level that can encourage this development.

If the child has poor coordination or fine motor skills, avoid toys with small pieces or toys that need precision touches to operate correctly.

Autistic children may like toys that vibrate like vibrating pillows or vibrating stuffed animals. They also may like things with slow repetitive motions like star projection lamps or other motion lamps.

Remember choosing the right toy can be a matter of life and death. Preventable injuries are the #1 killer of kids in the U.S. Every year, 9000 families lose a child because of a preventable injury. In the US nearly 9 million children are treated for injuries in the ER every year.


Remember choosing the right gift can be fun and exciting, when keeping the child's developmental level in mind. With developmental level in mind, education can easily be snuck into play.
